Attendance Tips During the Winter Months

Have a back-up plan for getting to school— many obstacles can block the way for your child to get to school in winter weather. If there is inclement weather check BCPS.org or local news for closings.

Do your best to keep your child healthy— Dress your child warmly and encourage to wash hands.

Learn how sick is too sick to send your child to school— *Fever— Any temperature over 100.4 is considered a fever. *Vomiting or Diarrhea— Student should be 20-24 hour symptom free . * Coughing that won't stop— If we kept every child with a cold home during winter months, there would be a lot of empty classrooms. But a really bad cough not only makes it hard for a child to learn or play, it also warrants a call to the doctor, as does breathing that sounds or looks different from usual.
